## **Affiliate Demographics**

- Approximately 50 professionals on list; 10-20 collegians
- 2006 activities have focused on supporting the Howard University Summer Actuarial Program (HUSAP)
- 2007 goals – continue/expand HUSAP support, expand relationship with collegians and professionals



## 2006 Activities

- HUSAP is a 3 week intensive program with 20-25 students
  - High school students (rising seniors) with strong math aptitude
  - Goal is to introduce them to the actuarial career path
  - Students study material for first two exams and take weekly exams
  - Program has been at Howard for over 20 years
- IABA involvement included the following:
  - Organized and provided guest speakers
  - Sponsored cook-out, which included an informal panel discussion on actuarial careers
    - 10 IABA professional members participated in panel discussion
    - Informal Q&A generated good discussion on opportunities and challenges in the actuarial profession
  - Feedback session at end of program led by Stafford Thompson



## 2007 Goals

- Continue/expand support for HUSAP
- Expand involvement with Actuarial Club at Howard University
  - Focuses on current college students
- Survey potential affiliate members (professional and collegiate) to determine specific activities that would be valuable
  - In past, have helped set up study groups, but have not seen consistent participation
- Solidify leadership roles/responsibilities within DC Affiliate
